Notice of Election and Nomination Paper

Nominations are invited not later than **9am Friday 10 May 2019** for the election of one parent governor to the governing body for a four year term.

- 1. All candidates, proposers and seconders must have parental responsibility for a child registered as a learner at school on Monday 29 May 2019
- 2. Candidates must agree to being nominated.
- 3. Nominations must be supported by a proposer and seconder.
- 4. Separate nomination paper must be used for each nomination.
- 5. Only nominations made using this form will be considered.
- 6. Paper copies of this nomination paper can be obtained from the school office.

If there is more than one nominations, a ballot will be held. Candidates may wish to provide a statement of not more than 100 words, which will be sent to parents with ballot papers in the event a ballot is required.
